The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C., has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 240, dated 12.12.2022, under Sections 323, 336, 341, 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Phase-1, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that initially the name of the petitioner was not mentioned in the list of accused but later on, on the basis of disclosure statement of Amanpreet Singh @ Aman Saini, the petitioner was nominated in the present case. It is asserted that no overt act or specific injury has been attributed to the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner today in Court, which is taken on record, according to which, the petitioner is behind the bars for the last 1 month and 23 days and is also

involved in two more cases. He opposes the prayer made in the present petition stating that the petitioner has actively participated in the commission of offence and one pistol was also recovered from the possession of the petitioner

Considering the afore-said facts and circumstances, especially the facts that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner; petitioner is in custody for the last more than one month, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
