The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 06.01.2020 vide which it was directed that in case the petitioner deposit a sum of Rs.2.00 lacs within a period of 15 days, the vehicle in question will be returned to him and the petitioner would further be held entitled to retain the said vehicle subject to payment of another sum of Rs.2.00 lacs by 20.02.2020.

Counsel appearing for the respondents has placed on record a subsequent order dated 27.01.2023, vide which the aforesaid order has been modified noticing the fact that the vehicle, in question has already been sold. It is further noticed in the order that the petitioner will approach the Finance Company within a period of one week along with an offer and a direction was issued to decide the representation.

Counsel for the respondents has further submitted that the petitioner never approached the respondent/Company.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
