Mr. Amit Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 by filing his Vakalatnama and the same is taken on record.

In compliance of the last order, respondent No.3 has produced the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 and 5 during the course of hearing.

Dr. Garima Sharma was appointed as a Counsellor in the present case to assist the Court. The counsellor also interacted with the petitioners as well as respondents No.4 and 5 and submitted a report which is taken on record. An amount of Rs.5000/- shall be paid by the High Court Legal Services Committee to the counsellor as her fees.

I have interacted with the petitioner No.1 as well as respondents No.4 and 5 in the chamber.

The petitioners stated that they are residing together and both are

major. They further stated that they apprehend threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and they also submitted a representation Annexure P-3 to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Karnal for the protection of lives and liberty.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, Superintendent of Police, Karnal is look into the representation made by the petitioners and to take action in accordance with law as early as possible.

In case, it is found that there is any threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, they may be kept in the Protection Home at Karnal or any other appropriate orders may be passed to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners.

With these observations made above, the present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
