This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.52 dated 29.03.2022, registered for offence under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Manimajra, U.T., Chandigarh. Another prayer has been made for setting aside the impugned order dated 27.01.2023, Annexure P-3, whereby the Non-bailable Warrants has been issued against the petitioner, who may be allowed to join the proceedings before the Trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to him in accordance with law.
