Already, there is a similar petition CRWP-695-2023 filed by the petitioner for claiming the similar kind of relief. In said petition, order dated 25.01.2023 says as under:

“This is the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking directions to respondents No.1 and 2 for protection of life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 3 to 8.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that at the instance of petitioner, FIR No.0156 dated 22.09.2022 under Sections 457, 380, 427 and 148 IPC was got registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda, but none of the accused-respondents No.3 to 5 have ever been arrested nor they have ever applied for bail, because they are in collusion with police officials.

Notice of motion for 16.02.2023.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 (State), and seeks time to file status report.”

On being confronted with the fact that already there is a similar kind of petition, which is pending consideration before this Court, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
