Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing the action of the respondents ordering recovery against them for difference in the Press Weight and Delivery Weight of Cotton Bales.

At the very outset, Mr. Sandeep Khunger, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 on advance notice states that not only the part recovery has been made, but otherwise also, the decision Annexure P-14 is appealable in terms of Rule 32 of the Cotton Corporation of India Limited Employees Conduct, Discipline and Appeal Rules, 1975.
