1. This petition is filed seeking quashing of order dated 25.10.2013 declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender.
2. On 19.4.2022, the following order was passed :-

“CRM-9312-2022

Allowed as prayed for and documents Annexures P-3 and P- 4 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-8634-2022

Prayer is for quashing of order dated 25.10.2013 passed by JMIC, Barnala whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No.32 dated 24.11.2011 registered under Sections 457, 380 IPC at Police Station Thuliwal, District Barnala on the ground that the matter has been compromised between the parties. In support of his contention, counsel for the petitioner referred to order dated 28.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRM-M-16079-2015 whereby aforesaid FIR has already been quashed qua co-accused Kiranjeet Kaur and Jaspal Singh.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions regarding the aforesaid compromise which is stated to have been effected between the parties.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before the next date fixed there and on doing so, he is ordered to be released on interim bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction till the next date fixed in the present petition.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to directions of this Court the petitioner had surrendered before the Court concerned and was released on bail.
4. In view of the above, no further directions are called for.
5. Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
6. Since the main case has been disposed of as infructuous the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
