This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.128, dated 19.09.2022, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda, under Sections 387, 336, 506, 120-B, 201, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 25(6), 27 of Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that identically situated co-accused Angrej Singh @ Laddi Sran has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-1302-2023 (Annexure P-2). Thus, the petitioner deserves the same concession.

Custody certificate dated 10.02.2023 checked by Sh.N.D. Negi, Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 03 months and 05 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that the petitioner is identically situated as aforementioned Angrej Singh @ Laddi Sran.

Thus, it is evident that the petitioner is covered by order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-1302-2023 (Annexure P-2). Accordingly, on the principle of parity, he also deserves to be granted regular bail. The petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
