ALOK JAIN, J. :

The present petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to lodge an FIR on the complaint made by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon various instructions issued by the Government at various occasions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact he has approached the Court below under the provisions of Section 156(2) but whichever counsel is engaged by the petitioner, the respondents start levelling allegations against that counsel, which leads to withdrawal of the counsel from the case.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to approach the trial Court under the provisions of law. However, he submits that the respondents may not be permitted to raise any complaint against the counsel engaged by the petitioner. This issue be also highlighted in the complaint if so filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise the issue before the Court below, which shall take strict action in case the respondents abuse the process of law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
