The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.078 dated 12.10.2022 under Sections 379-B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 08.02.2023, the petitioner had been granted concession of interim bail in the following terms:-

“Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and was nominated as an accused pursuant to the disclosure statement made by co-accused. He further submits that the petitioner has no criminal past and there is no criminal case registered against him as well.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.02.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 08.02.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
