The instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.395 dated 24.11.2020, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379-B and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Patran District Patiala on the basis of compromise dated 12.03.2021 (Annexure P-2).

On 21.02.2023, a direction was issued to both the parties concerned to get their statements recorded before the Magistrate concerned.

As per the report of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Samana dated 25.08.2023, both the parties failed to cause appearance and get their statements recorded before the learned Illaqa Magistrate.

Again on 18.05.2023, on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, one more opportunity was granted to both the parties to get their statements recorded before the learned Illaqa Magistrate. Now, the learned Illaqa

Magistrate has submitted its report dated 08.11.2023, this time also the parties could not cause their appearance before the trial Court, despite the specific direction given by this Court. It seems that the compromise has not been effected between the parties, therefore, no useful purpose would be served to grant third opportunity to the parties.

Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed, however with liberty to the petitioner and respondent No.2 to re-access this Court in case the compromise is duly executed between the parties.
