The petitioners assail the correctness of seniority list issued on 01.01.2019 with respect to the Multi Purpose Health Supervisor (male). On reading of the petition, it is evident that the petitioners have not disclosed as to when the tentative seniority list was issued. It has also not been disclosed whether the petitioners filed any objections or not. Moreover, the writ petition has been filed by only impleading the official respondents. The officials who will get adversely affected have not been impleaded as respondents.

Thus, the writ petition is bereft of the necessary particulars. Moreover, it is filed after a period of more than four years.

Hence, this Court does not find it appropriate to exercise jurisdiction under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

Dismissed.
