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**SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)**

Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to offer appointment letter to the petitioner for the post of MPHW (Male) in the SC category.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to advertisement No.01/2015, Annexure P-1, petitioner applied for the post of MPHW (Male), which was shown under Category No.7 in the advertisement in the SC category. It is his categorical case that the petitioner cleared the written test as well as the interview and his roll number has been mentioned in the final result, announced on 05.06.2019, Annexure P-13. He submits that despite this fact, petitioner has not been offered appointment in the SC category, although, an offer had been made to the petitioner in some other category. Counsel submits that petitioner has submitted legal notice dated 19.08.2022, Annexure P-14, followed by a reminder dated 14.12.2022, Annexure P-15,

which are pending. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director General, Health Services (Malaria), Panchkula to look into the legal notice.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.K.S.Brar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without examining the claim of the petitioner on merits and without calling for a response from the respondents, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the legal notice, Annexure P-14, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

In case, respondent No.2 finds that offer of appointment cannot be given to the petitioner, he shall pass a speaking order assigning reasons for rejection within the aforesaid period.
