Mr. Ashok Kaushik, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the complainant in this revision petition and has filed his Power of Attorney in the Court and the same has been placed on the record. He has also submitted the copy of the order passed by learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Palwal on 16.11.2021, whereby the said Board has opined that the revisionist-petitioner was required to be tried as an adult and has referred the criminal case arisen out of FIR bearing No.17 dated 13.01.2020 registered at Police Station Mundkati, Palwal, under Sections 302 & 201 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, to the Children Court for his (revisionist-petitioner's) trial and the afore-said order has also been placed on the file.

At this stage, learned counsel for the revisionist-petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant revision petition, while submitting that in view of the above-referred order, the revisionist-petitioner intends to avail the appropriate and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to him under law, before the concerned trial Court itself.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant have no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the revision petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
