1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to set aside the order dated 09.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, whereby the Court had directed the petitioner to deposit 20% of the amount of compensation imposed by the Trial Court within a period of 60 days.
2. Pursuant to the notice, Mr. Raghujeet Singh Madaan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1/complainant by filing his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record and Mr. Krishan Kanha, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 by filing his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for respondent No.1/ complainant submits that he has no objection in case, the petitioner deposits 20% of the cheque amount today in the Court, in compliance of the impugned order dated 09.12.2022 passed by Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over drafts Nos.059105 and 059106 for an amount of Rs.2,60,792/- each i.e 20% of the amount of compensation (Rs.26,07,920/-) and the said drafts have been handed over to learned counsel to the respondent No.1/complainant in the Court today itself.

5. Since the petitioner has paid the 20% of the amount of compensation imposed by the Trial Court to the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1/complainant, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed off.

6. All other pending applications, if any, are also disposed off, accordingly.
