1. This second petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
395	08.08.2021	City, Sirsa, District Sirsa	304-B, 498-A IPC

2. Custody certificate dated 08.11.2023 has been filed by the State
counsel, which is taken on record.

3. Upon instructions from PSI Shishpal, State counsel submits that
all the prosecution witnesses except one have been examined. He submits
that the Investigating Officer, who is the sole witness left out had

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appeared before the trial Court on the previous date, but could not be examined due to paucity of time.

4. Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the present petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.

6. Counsel for the petitioner, however requests that as the petitioner is in custody since 10.08.2021, a direction be issued to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

7. His request has been considered.

8 Noticing that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 24 months, trial Court is requested to make an endeavour and expedite the trial.
