ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 CrPC seeking regular bail in case FIR No.12 dated 01.06.2017 registered under Sections 21 & 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station SSOC, Amritsar.

During pendency of the petition, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner on medical grounds, vide order dated 10.09.2020, which is continuing till date.

Petitioner has filed an application i.e. CRM-12692-2023, to place on record the medical documents. Although, medical documents are not complete but still, considering the over-all medical condition of the petitioner, interim order is extended till 17.04.2023.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition for interim bail on medical grounds by 11.04.2023. He is also at liberty to file a separate petition for regular bail after surrender. Petitioner is directed to annex complete photocopies of the medical record which he had annex in the present petition till date. It is clarified that the petitioner shall serve advance copy of the petition to counsel for the State positively by 11.04.2023, to enable the investigator to verify the medical condition of the petitioner. It is further clarified that Registry shall not raise objection qua surrender of the petitioner, if fresh bail petition under Section 439 CrPC, if any is filed on medical grounds.

Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
