DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 19.01.2023 registered under Section 452, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

(2) On 08.02.2023 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case on account of political rivalry in the village; the petitioner has no other criminal antecedents; even if the case of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, no injury is attributed to the petitioner; even otherwise all the injuries inflicted on the complainant's sons are simple in nature and that the petitioner is also ready and willing to join and cooperate with the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Arun Luthra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 04.05.2023.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.10, dated 19.01.2023, registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

(3) Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that the State no longer requires the petitioner for investigation purposes.

(4) In the light of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner as have been recorded in the afore quoted order as also the statement made on behalf of the State, subject to the petitioner’s abiding by the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C the order of this Court dated 08.02.2023, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
