LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing the respondents to regularize/settle loan account of the petitioners under the prevalent One Time Settlement scheme. Further prayer is for restraining respondents from taking over physical possession of the property in question.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that this writ petition is infact infructuous as petitioners' account has been settled and closed. Photocopy of clearance certificate dated 24.05.2021 issued by the State Bank of India furnished in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions. Keeping in view the categoric submission on behalf of the respondents, we do not any ground whatsoever for continuance of the present proceedings, notwithstanding absence of learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. This writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous. Needless to say, liberty is afforded to the petitioners to file an appropriate application in this writ petition within four weeks in case any incorrect fact has been set forth before this Court.
