MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.426 dated 13.07.2022 under Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC registered at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

2. Vide order dated 09.02.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner had been granted interim anticipatory bail with direction to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 09.02.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that during the pendency of the instant petition, the parties have effected an amicable settlement on 01.05.2023.

4. Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the

complainant, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the complainant does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner that the parties have effected an amicable settlement.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material on record.

7. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 09.02.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
