Notice in the application.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State, who was already served with an advance copy of the application. He has no objection in case the instant application is allowed and accused persons are arrayed in the memo of parties as respondents No.6 to 10.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel, the application is allowed, which is duly supported by an affidavit of the applicant-petitioner.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

CRWP-1235-2023

This is a criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and protection from false implication in a criminal case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of this Court to an earlier representation dated 01.06.2022 (Anneuxre P-3). In pursuance thereof, an FIR was registered on 08.10.2022 (Annexure P-4), under Section 307 apart from other provisions of IPC, 1860.

The contention of the counsel for the petitioner is that police is hand in glove, who deleted Section 307 of IPC from the said FIR and having advantage of the same, the private respondents again threatened to the petitioner. At this stage, last representation dated 10.12.2022 (Anneuxre P-7) was made.

The grievance raised by Ms. Kapila, learned Advocate, after having submitted the aforesaid representation is that the authorities have not taken any action whatsoever on the said representation dated 10.12.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is pending with DIG, Boarder Ranger, Amritsar.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State, who on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh submits that representation dated 10.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) shall be considered and a speaking order be passed in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from today.

It is also directed that a copy of the order so passed be served to the petitioner.

In view of the afore-said terms, petition is disposed of.
