Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is to quash FIR No.195 dated 11.04.2022 registered at Police Station City Sohna, Gurugram under Section 174-A IPC, on account of declaration of petitioner as a proclaimed person by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sohna vide order dated 22.03.2017 in complaint case bearing No.NI ACT 182 of 2015 titled as "Om Filling Status Versus Sher Mohammad",.

It is contended that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person on 22.03.2017. However, the said proceedings declaring him as proclaimed person have already been set aside by this Court vide order dated 25.01.2023 in CRM-M-22352 of 2022 (copy Annexure P.4). It is contended that at the time of filing the earlier petition, petitioner was not aware that consequent to the declaration of the petitioner as proclaimed person, present FIR had already been registered.

Notice of motion.

Considering the fact that proceedings whereby petitioner was declared as proclaimed person have already been quashed by this Court vide order dated 25.01.2023 in CRM-M-22352 of 2022, therefore, the

consequent proceedings, i.e. registration of the FIR under Section 174-A
IPC also stand quashed.
