VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is the second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.14 dated 31.01.2022 registered under Sections 325, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149, 34 PC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police within a period of one month and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 5 days.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application, however, does not object to the said course of action.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn,

with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the police within a period of one month and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 5 days from the date of the said application being moved.
