The petitioner is alleging the violation of order dated 28.11.2019, passed by the Collector, Kapurthala entertaining an appeal under the Punjab Land Revenue Act against an order dated passed by the Assistant Collector, who was ceased of the partition of land *inter se* parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the aforesaid order, the respondent-Naib Tehsildar/Assistant Collector, First Grade, Tehsil Dhilwan, District Kapurthala has proceeded further on the basis of a Naksha prepared by the field staff in terms of Sections 113 and 116 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that order dated 02.12.2019, passed by the Assistant Collector is appealable and he has already filed an appeal against the same.

In view of the above, no contempt is made out.

Dismissed.
