AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 16.12.2014 in FIR No. 135 dated 10.07.2009 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nakodar, District Jalandhar, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed person.

2. On 28.02.2023, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 16.12.2014 passed in case FIR No.135 dated 10.07.2009, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 324, 323, 341 & 34 IPC whereby, the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court and the Court may be directed to decide his bail application within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harkanwarjit Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and waives service.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on 09.03.2023 at 10.00 a.m. If, he seeks grant of bail, the said

application shall be decided within 15 days.
Adjourned to 02.05.2023.”

2. Thereafter, on 01.08.2023, this Court passed an order which reads thus:-

“Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Zorawar Singh, states that the petitioner has not complied with order dated 28.02.2023 passed by this Court as he has not surrendered before the trial Court on 09.03.2023. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
In the interest of justice, adjourned to 09.08.2023.
Date be notified to the learned counsel for the petitioner.”

3. As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioner has been informed through e-mail, however, still there is no representation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Kumar, submits that the petitioner in compliance of the directions passed by this Court has not surrendered.
5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
