Prayer in this application is for exempting the petitioners from filing certified/typed copies of the Annexures P1 to P4.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed, subject to just all exceptions.

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The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 16.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal, Haryana and he shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 16.01.2023 (Annexure P-4).

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2– The Superintendent of Police, District Palwal, Haryana is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
