ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 24.07.2019, passed by this Court in CRM-M-29655-2019, vide which, respondent-accused/Kaushik Chatterjee was restrained from taking any step, which may amount to interference in the investigation of the FIR and threatening the witnesses directly or indirectly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent-accused has sent certain communication to the employees of the petitioner-company on Whats App regarding reputation of the company, in which, certain details about the pendency of the FIR and cases against the respondent are given.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the same amount to interference in the investigation of the case.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 as well as learned State

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counsel submit that the investigation is complete and *challan* has already been presented before the Illaqua Magistrate, therefore, there is no possibility for the respondent/accused to tamper with the evidence of the prosecution.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 further submits that even respondent No. 1 has filed a complaint against the petitioner-company, therefore, the present contempt petition has been filed as a counter-blast to the same. It is further submitted that in fact the petitioner is trying to create grounds for cancellation of the regular bail granted to respondent No. 1.

Be whatsoever, once the investigation is complete and *challan* stands presented, there is no willful disobedience on the part of the respondent/accused.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.
