Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order of lease (Annexure P-2) in respect of the land forming part of kabristan/graveyards passed by respondents No.2 and 3 in favour of respondents No.4 to 6 and for directing the respondents not to interfere in the possession and user of dedication and from changing nature of the land.

Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that the possession of the property has been handed over to the Wakf Board rendering the present petition as infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also affirmed the above-said fact.

nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present case which has been
