**VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)**

A bunch of 15 writ petitions is being decided by this common order with the consent of the parties since the issues involved therein are identical and the counsel for the parties agree that the same may be adjudicated together.

All these matters relate to release of outstanding dues/payments of the petitioner(s) qua the works allotted to and executed by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) in CWP-11673-2023 and CWP-11686-2023 submits that formal notice of motion has not been issued in the said petitions so far.

Notice of motion in the said petitions.

Learned counsel already appearing on behalf of the respective respondents also accept notice in the above mentioned two writ petitions and waive service.

Mr. B.R. Mahajan, Sr. Advocate submits that the respondent(s)-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad is already in the process of clearing the admitted and outstanding payments of all the petitioners herein and that certain bills have remained pending on account of administrative works relating to either change in the scope of the work or the enhancement thereof, which necessitated for seeking fresh administrative approvals. He contends that additional demand has also been raised by the respondents-Municipal Corporation, Faridabad from the Government. He contends that all pending claims and appropriates decisions at

the Administrative levels shall be examined and a uniform decision shall be taken within a period of two months and the admissible payments shall be released within a period of two months thereafter.

State Counsel undertakes that the demand as raised by the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad for clearing the outstanding payments shall be released expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from the date as and when such demand is raised by the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

Mr. B.R. Mahajan, Sr. Advocate further contends that in view of process having been undertaken and the timelines for the release of the payment i.e. within a period of two months as suggested above, the grievances of the petitioners would stand redressed.

Learned counsel for the respective petitioners have no objection to the above said statement made by the learned counsel for the State as well as the respondents-M.C. Faridabad.

Accordingly, all the petitions are disposed of in the above terms.

However, it is made clear that in case the payment is not released within the period as undertaken above, the petitioners shall be entitled to interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the present petition(s) till actual realization.
