The petitioner has filed the present petition seeking anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.130 dated 30.05.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Barara, Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 10.03.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
