The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take stern appropriate legal action on the representations of the petitioner dated 10.01.2023 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) against the private respondents and to stop harassment of the petitioner and her family from the hands of private respondents, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even on second call.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, P.S. Dasuya, Hoshiarpur, has submitted that on receipt of the complaint from the petitioner, the proceedings under Sections 107 and 151 Cr.P.C. were initiated against the private respondents. Thereafter, no complaint has been received from the petitioner. Hence, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

In view of the prayer made in the petition, contents of the petition, as well as, the submissions made by learned State counsel, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
