MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.0375 dated 26.08.2022 (P-1), under Sections 120-B, 384, 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 7, District Panchkula, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 05.02.2023 (P-2), entered into between the parties i.e. petitioner as well as respondent Nos.2 and 3.

2. Learned State counsel raised an objection on the premise that the petitioner is facing two other criminal cases, which are as follows:

(1) FIR No.242 dated 26.06.2022, under Sections 193, 384, 406, 409, 467, 468, 471, 212, 506, 420, 180, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 7 and 13 of the

Prevention of Corruption Act, at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

(2) FIR No.24 dated 21.01.2023, under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 384, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula.

3. Faced with the above situation, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed off.
