Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner at present is tried as adult and the trial is pending before Sessions Court at Sonapat. The petitioner was initially tried as juvenile, however, at present he is facing trial as adult.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on being confronted with the fact that earlier bail application was rejected by Juvenile Justice Board and at present, trial is pending before Sessions Court, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to move appropriate application before Sessions Court. He further prays that interim bail may be continued till adjudication of the bail application by trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to approach Sessions Court for regular bail. If petitioner surrenders before trial Court on or before 15.01.2023 and seeks regular bail, the trial Court shall decide his application within two days.
