The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5, who has allegedly been trying to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner with the help of recovery agents and their henchmen. It is also the case of the petitioner that though representation (Annexure P-2) dated 09.01.2020 in the said regard was made to the official respondents, however, they had been sitting over the matter and had failed to initiate any action against respondent No.5.

Learned State counsel while drawing the attention of this Court to the affidavit dated 16.12.2020 filed on behalf of the official respondents, submits that no such representation has been received by

the authorities concerned and in fact, it was a fabricated representation, which had been annexed with the instant petition.

Case has been called, however nobody has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

In the circumstances, coupled with the submissions made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same stands dismissed accordingly. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail of any other alternate remedy, as may be available to him under the provisions of law.
