Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that order dated 22.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-21857-2022 titled as **Paramjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others** by this Court has not been complied with as the direction given by this Court to decide the legal notice dated 22.03.2019 (Annexure P/2) within a period of 08 weeks is yet to be complied with hence, the respondents intentionally and wilfully disobeyed the order of this Court and they are liable to be proceeded under the Contempt of Court Act.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gurvinder Singh, AAG, Punjab accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that keeping in view the instructions received by him, in case an appropriate order on the legal notice dated

22.03.2019 of the petitioner has not been passed, the same will be passed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement given by the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed at this stage with liberty to revive the same in case the said direction is not complied with by the respondents.
