By way of this writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the official respondent Nos.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the private respondents who are in lookout to kill him and his family members and who have falsely implicated the petitioner's father in a false cases.

As per the reply filed by way of affidavit of Shri Rajneet Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, no representation was ever received from the petitioner. Petitioner is not required in any other case. There was some dispute between respondent No.7 and the father of the petitioner, which has since been amicably settled in the Panchayat.

As per the affidavit of Shri Sarabjit Singh, Assistant Inspector General of Police, Litigation, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, father of the petitioner is involved in two cases, bearing FIR No.202, dated 18.12.2021, registered at Police Station City-1, Sangrur,

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under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, in which challan has already been presented; and FIR No.38, dated 13.01.2022, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of IPC, in which also challan has already been presented. It is further stated that there is no truth in the allegations regarding any threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, who is the son of Rajender Kumar, accused in two cases.

Having regard to the status report filed on behalf of both the States, Punjab and Haryana, no further action is required in this case.
