Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.297 dated 07.08.2010 (P-1), under Sections 201, 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani.

(2) Learned State Counsel, on instructions, has apprised the Court that petitioner avoided process of law for a long period; his role is specifically mentioned even in the FIR and trial is at fag end.

(3) Faced with the above situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that present petition be disposed off as not pressed at this stage.

- (5) However, keeping in view the custody of petitioner, learned trial Court is requested to proceed in the matter, expeditiously.
