This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ, direction, order especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 18.12.2022 (Annexure P-11).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since, the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Gidderbaha, vide order dated 03.11.2022 (Annexure P-10) had directed the revenue authorities to proceed for demarcation, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue his remedy before the Civil Court.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.
