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**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to re-issue his passport.

2. The petitioner was issued passport on 28.06.2006 which was valid upto 27.06.2016. Four FIRs came to be registered against the petitioner. The petitioner has been acquitted in FIR No.110 dated 12.07.2016 and FIR No.130 dated 24.08.2016. FIR No.128 dated 23.08.2016 has been quashed vide order dated 08.07.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M-40963-2016. FIR No.11 dated 05.03.2022 has been quashed by this Court vide order dated 02.08.2023 passed in CRM-M-29306-2022. As on day, no FIR is pending against the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforestated

position.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent-UIO faced with aforesaid facts submits that competent authority would pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks from today.

5. In the wake of statements made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition stands disposed of.
