AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action on the representation of the petitioner dated 10th November, 2018.
2. The dispute in the present case is that there was an alleged fraudulent debit entry of amount ₹1,30,000/- in Bank account of the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh submits that representation was considered and rejected considering that petitioner has a remedy before the banking ombudsman. He further submits that petitioner can collect the report qua the representation on any working day from the SHO, Division No.5, Ludhiana.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is disposed of.
5. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
6. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
