Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0009 dated 08.10.2022, under Section 66(D) of Information Technology Act, 2000 and Section 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Cyber Manesar, District Gurugram, Haryana along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.12.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and in the facts and circumstances of the case, prosecution of the petitioner would be nothing but an abuse of the process of the Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Kartik, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3. He has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner. However, learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is under investigation and the

petitioner is yet to join investigation.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy as in accordance with law.

Allowed to do so.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. However, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the investigating agency is directed to conclude the investigation within four weeks from today keeping in view the fact that both the sides have amicably resolved the issue.
