Application is allowed, as prayed for.

CWP-3019-2023

The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revert back her to the post of Sweeper instead of Gardener (Mali).

It is contended that the petitioner has joined as Sweeper since the year 2020, however, respondents No.2 and 3 have changed her nature of job from Sweeper to Mali. Counsel would submit that in this regard, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 31.05.2022, Annexure P-3, to respondent No.2, which has not been decided as yet. Counsel would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Appearance has also been caused by Mr. Abhishek Jindal, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3.

Let adequate number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to the respective counsel appearing on behalf of respondents during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 31.05.2022, Annexure P-3, of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
