Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant 2nd Assured Career Progression (ACP), due on 01.11.2013 and 3rd ACP due on 01.11.2017, as per the Notification of the year 2014 and to recalculate the pension on grant of 2nd and 3rd ACP along with interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was appointed as S.S. Master; that the petitioner has forgone the promotion in the year 2013; that thereafter, the petitioner made out his case of promotion to the post of Elementary School Headmaster from Head Master and that the case of the petitioner is covered under Rule 14(2) of the Notification dated 28.10.2016, but the 2nd and 3rd ACP have not been granted to the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has represented the department vide representations dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) and the petitioner will be satisfied, if his said representation is decided by respondents within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
