The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.03 dated 27.7.2022 registered under sections 419, 420 IPC at Police Station, Cyber Crime, District Faridabad along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 6.2.2023 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after registration of the FIR parties have amicably settled their dispute and have arrived at a compromise. He submits that the present FIR was registered due to some misunderstanding between the parties. He submits that the dispute is purely civil in nature and that prosecution of the petitioner in the present FIR is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Nafeesh Ahmed, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 has endorsed the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner and has not denied the factum of compromise effected between the parties.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that case is under investigation as the challan is yet to be presented.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to conclude the investigation of the case keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and that parties have duly compromised the matter, within a period of four weeks from today.
