This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed with the prayer to quash the FIR No.110 dated 23.10.2019 under Section 304-A, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka and all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 12.02.2020 a co-ordinate bench of this Court directed issuance of notice of motion on the point of maintainability.
