The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 & 2 to immediately restrain respondent No.3 (and similarly situated operators) from running plying Trucks/Trailers in Overloaded capacity on National Highway as the same is in contravention and violation of the directions laid down under Notification passed by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways under the provisions of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 (Annexure P-1)

After arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
