Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.121 dated 28.8.2021 registered under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 308, 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bahavwala, District Fazilka.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations appearing on record, only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner and in compliance of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police. State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagraj Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the

case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 2.3.2022

is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
