The petitioner, on attaining the age of superannuation, retired in November, 1998. This writ petition was filed in the year 1995. She claims the benefits of the military service rendered by her as a Commission Officer w.e.f 19.04.1966 to 04.12.1975 by granting increments, absentia promotion, leave and counting of her military service towards the further promotions, proficiency step up increments etc. etc.

The petitioner's claim is contested by the respondents on the ground that in the year 1972, the petitioner refused to come back to the civil service, though, she re-joined the same on 05.12.1975. However, she remained absent from duty for about 9 years till 07.01.1987. It has been claimed that the petitioner has not completed 8 years of uninterrupted service w.e.f 01.01.1986.

No replication has been filed by the learned counsel representing the petitioner to controvert the aforesaid facts.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it to be a fit case to exercise its extraordinary writ jurisdiction.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
