1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 13.01.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.3 and 5 has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner has died and the impugned order was an interim order passed by the appellate authority and consequently, the appellate authority had passed a final order regarding which a separate writ petition has been filed and thus, on the said two accounts, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the

said facts.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. In case any cause survives, it would be open to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present writ petition.
