AMARJOT BHATTI, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed revision petition against impugned order dated 09.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) vide which warrants of sale were issued and it was adjourned for 19.11.2022 for awaiting report. During the pendency of the present revision, the sale of property in question was stayed to the extent of share of the petitioner vide order dated 17.03.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that he has already filed third party objections before the Executing Court which are still pending. The copy of application regarding third party objections is Annexure P-5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further pointed out that before proceeding further on the basis of impugned order dated 09.11.2022, Annexure P-4, the Executing Court may be directed to dispose of his third party objections.

3. Counsel for the respondent Nos.1 and 2 are also present in the Court and they have no objections if the third party objections are disposed of before proceedings further on the basis of impugned order dated 09.11.2022.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, the present revision is disposed of by directing the Executing Court to dispose of third party objections, Annexure P-5, as per law, before proceedings further on the basis of impugned order dated 09.11.2022.

5. The Civil Revision is, accordingly, disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
